Introduction

Course Structure

The EDHR aims to focus more on the basics of human rights concepts and leading the teaching and learning activities towards contemporary challenges of human rights. The modules consists of the following main areas:

- (2) Gradual Evolution of Generational Rights: Civil, Political, Economic, Social and Cultural.
- (3) An Introduction to International Human Rights Lawand International Human Rights Mechanisms: UNO.
- (4) Domestic Legal System and Fundamental Rights.
- (5) State Responsibilities and Obligations relating to Human Rights: International and Regional Levels.
- (6) Violations of Human Rights and/or Fundamental Rights, and Domestic & International Remedial Measures/ Mechanisms.
- (7) Law Enforcement and Human Rights: Protectionand Promotion of Human Rights
- (8) Evolving New Types of Rights: individual & grouprights: women, children, minority, refugee, IDPs etc.
- (9) Contemporary Challenges of Human Rights: Domestic and International Challenges.
- (10) Elective Seminars on Special Topics.
