- ▶ Any other Bachelor's degree, with prior learning/work experience in Development studies; **OR**
- ▶ Postgraduate Diploma (SLQF 8) from a recognized University/Institution or an equivalent Qualification acceptable to the Faculty Board and Senate of the University with prior learning/work experience in Development studies; **OR**
- ▶ Professional qualification in Development studies from a recognized professional body which is acceptable to the Faculty Board and Senate of the University with prior learning/work experience in Development studies; **OR**
- ▶ Completion of NVQ level 7 (Equivalent to bachelor's degree in SLQF) with relevant work experience in Development as determined by the Faculty Board and Senate of the University; **AND**
- ▶ A good knowledge of the English language and satisfactory performance at a selection test/ selection interview.
