Introduction

Area studies e.g. American Studies, Japanese Studies; Chinese Studies and so on are respectable interdisciplinary areas of undergraduate and postgraduate study in many universities in the world. No Sri Lankan University had a programme of this nature until the Faculty of Graduate Studies embarked on the MA in Japanese Stud-ies way back in 1987.

Aside form the world wide interest on Japan as the second largest economy and its strength, its rich social, historical and cultural heritage is not paid much attention even in Asia. There is a tendency among policy makers in Japan today to encourage and support attempts of Asian people to study social cultural and historical aspects of the Japanese society, in addition to its economic aspect.

The increasing interest of Sri Lankan students to study the Japanese Language is well known. In addition there is an increasing interest to study in Japan, particularly at graduate level. The Master's Degree (MJS) course in Japanese Studies in the University might be of great benefit to these students, who could first obtain their MJS here and then seek scholarship support to continue toward doctoral studies.



Objectives

The main objectives of the programme are as follows:

- To impart to students an indepth knowledge about the historical development and current conditions of Japanese society, culture and the economy.;
- To develop language abilities for communication purposes and to develop an appreciation for basic Japanese literature in beginners;
- To impart an in-depth knowledge about Japanese business and management practices in order to enable students to facilitate business transactions in Japan;
- To improve research capabilities of the students who will proceed for higher studies like M.Phil./Ph.D. courses in Japanese Universities.

Admission Requirements

The minimum entry requirements for the PgDBM shall be as follows:

- A Bachelor's degree from a recognized University/Institution in Japanese Studies; OR
- Any other Bachelor's degree, with prior learning/work experience in Japanese Studies; **OR**
- Postgraduate Diploma (SLQF 8) from a recognized University/ Institution or an equal qualification acceptable to the Faculty Board of the FGS and the Senate of the University of Colombo with prior learning/ work experience in Japanese Studies; OR
- Professional qualification from a recognized professional body acceptable to the Faculty Board of the FGS and Senate of University of Colombo with prior learning/ work experience in Japanese Studies; OR
- Completion of NVQ level 7 (equivalent to Bachelors degree in SLQF) with relevant work experience in Japanese Studies as determined by the Faculty Board of the FGS and Senate of the University of Colombo;

AND

A good knowledge of English language and satisfactory performance at a selection test/ selection interview.
