Admission Requirements

- ▶ A Bachelor's degree from a recognized University/ Institution with manufacturing and allied subject area; **OR**
- ▶ Any other Bachelor's degree, with learning/work experience in manufacturing and allied subject area; **OR**
- ▶ The Postgraduate Diploma in Manufacturing Management offered by the FGS; **OR**
- ▶ A Postgraduate Diploma offered by any recognized university in a relevant discipline acceptable to the Senate of the University; **OR**
- ▶ Professional qualification in manufacturing or allied subject area from a recognized professional body which is acceptable to the Faculty Board of the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Senate of the University with prior learning/work experience in manufacturing and allied subject area; **OR**
- ▶ Completion of NVQ level 7 (equivalent to Bachelor's degree in SLQF) with relevant work experience in manufacturing and allied subject area as determined by the Faculty Board and the Senate of the University;

AND

- ▶ Good knowledge of English language and satisfactory performance at a selection test and/or interview.
