Introduction

Admission Requirements

- A Bachelor's degree from a recognized University / Institution in Public Administration; OR
- Any other Bachelor's degree, with prior learning / work experience in Public Administration; OR
- Postgraduate Diploma (SLQF 8) from a recognized University / Institution or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Faculty Board and the Senate of the University of Colombo with prior learning / work experience in Public Administration; OR
- Professional qualification in Public Administration from a recognized professional body acceptable to the Faculty Board of the Faculty of Graduate Studies and the Senate of University with prior learning / work experience in Public Administration; OR
- Completion of NVQ level 7 (Equivalent to Bachelor's degree in SLQF) with relevant work experience in Public Administration as determined by the Faculty Board and the Senate of the University; AND
- A good knowledge of English language and satisfactory performance at a selection test and /or an interview.



Medium and Methods of Instruction

English will be the medium of instruction. The teaching method will be online with the application of hybrid mode for review workshops. Candidates can follow the courses of study from their place of work or residences and they are not required to come to the University to attend the lectures. Candidates will be required to sit the written examination and write an independent study. This programme intends to provide knowledge in a theoretical sense as well as at a practical level.
