INTRODUCTION

OBJECTIVE

The Focus of this Programme is on educating and training students in both theoretical and Practical aspects of human rights application, drawing knowledge from historical, philosophical, legal, international and domestic dimension of human rights. It will also inculcate analytical skills amongst students, enabling them to undertake research and/or to be involved in the promotion and protection of human rights.

STRUCTURE

The Teaching will be mainly based on application and the case-study approach, in addition to more traditional methods.

STRUCTURE

The Prospective Candidates for this course will be human rights activists, NGO personnel, lawyers, activists in social development, academics, diplomats, Journalists, personnel from the armed forces and the police, and enthusiasts in this field.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ A Bachelor's degree from a recognized University/ Institute in the relevant field; **OR**
 - ✓ Any other Bachelor's degree, with prior learning/ work experience in the relevant field; **OR**
 - ✓ A relevant Professional qualification from a recognized professional body acceptable to the Faculty Board and the Senate of the University of Colombo with prior learning/ work experience in the relevant field; **OR**
 - ✓ Completion of NVQ Level 07 (equivalent to Bachelor's degree in SLQF) with relevant work experience in the relevant field as determined by the Faculty Board and the Senate; **OR**
 - ✓ A Diploma or a Higher Diploma from a recognized institute or university or an equivalent qualification to SLQF Three/Four (03/04) with work experience of Two/Three (02/03) years, as the case may be, relevant to the Postgraduate Diploma Programme as may be determined by the Faculty Board of the FGS and Senate of the University of Colombo; **AND**
 - ✓ A good knowledge of English language and satisfactory performance at a selection test and/ or an interview.
- Each application under clause (iv) and (v) shall be considered on its merit.
