INTRODUCTION

The Postgraduate Diploma in Development Studies - PGDip (Dev St) provides knowledge in multidisciplinary fields paying special attention to the current needs of the developing countries. The curriculum of the programme is designed to treat development issues in a multi-disciplinary context.

OBJECTIVE

Objective of the program is to provide in-depth understanding of development related issues and discourses, both theoretical and practical.

TARGET GROUP

The purpose of this program is to ensure that there is qualified, efficient, and innovative individuals are available to satisfy the challenging needs of qualified staff in public and private institutions in Sri Lanka. The program is designed to cater to those who are actively involved in development related activities and those who are planning to involve in such activities in the future. They may belong to various training, educational backgrounds and disciplines such as Economics, Geography, Sociology, Political Science, History, Demography, Law, Science, Management, Medicine and other disciplines.

MEDIUM AND METHODS OF INSTRUCTION

English will be the medium of instruction. The teaching method will be online with the application of hybrid mode for review workshops. Candidates can follow the courses of study from their place of work or residences and they are not required to come to the University to attend the lectures. Candidates will be required to sit the written examination. This programme intends to provide knowledge in a theoretical sense as well as at a practical level.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- (i) A Bachelor's degree from a recognized University/Institution in development studies or related subject area; OR
- (ii) Any other Bachelor's degree, with prior learning/work experience in development studies or related subject area; OR
- (iii) Professional qualification in development studies or related subject area from a recognized professional body acceptable to the Faculty Board and Senate of the University with prior learning/ work experience in development studies or related subject area; OR
- (iv) Completion of NVQ level 7 (equivalent to Bachelor's degree in SLQF) with relevant work experience in development studies or related subject area as determined by the Faculty Board and the Senate; OR
- (v) Diploma or Higher Diploma from the University of Colombo or an equivalent qualification to SLQF Three/Four (03/04) with two/three years relevant work experience in development studies or related subject area as determined by the Faculty Board and Senate of the University; AND
- A good knowledge of English language and satisfactory performance at a selection test and/or selection interview.
- Each application under clause (iv) and clause (v) shall be considered on its merit.
